

**Sub: Directions of Hon'ble NGT under order dated 10.05.2019 in OA No. 32/2014.**

Pursuant to orders dated 10.05.2019 of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT), in the above mentioned OA, the assessment units of Pali district, Rajasthan, are hereby notified as Over-Exploited, Critical, Safe as shown below. The categorization of assessment units is as per the Assessment of Dynamic Ground Water Resources (2017) carried out jointly by the Central Ground Water Board, Government of India and the State Ground Water Department, Government of Rajasthan.
